

INTERDISCIPLINARY STUDIES

Overview

An Interdisciplinary Studies/General Studies degree program is a flexible degree option to allow students to combine MWSU academic programs of study into a customizable plan to fit individualized educational and career goals. These include the Bachelor of General Studies (composed of existing MWSU minors or a customized concentration), the Bachelor of Science in Technology (created for those possessing a transcript from military services), and three interdisciplinary minors (Childhood Studies, Cognitive Science, and Entrepreneurship). Students will design a plan of study under the guidance of an academic advisor and from the recommendation of departments and programs.
